### Inclement Weather Policy

- If Baltimore County is CLOSED for the day, there will be NO Netivon classes
- If Baltimore County is DELAYED OPENING, there WILL BE Netivon classes
- If Baltimore County CLOSES EARLY, then there will be NO Netivon classes
- If the weather gets worse on a day after Baltimore County has already had a full day, Netivon will make its own decision; families will receive an email if classes are cancelled.
- If the weather gets worse during the middle of Netivon classes, we will have students call home to make arrangements for an early dismissal
- For Sunday sessions, families will receive an email if classes are cancelled.

We are pleased to offer a new buffet dinner program for all Netivon students. Join us for delicious buffet dinners with your friends on Tuesdays and Thursdays throughout the year. The cost is \$8 per person per buffet meal/date.

You may sign up for as many or as few dinner buffets as you like. See the schedule below for dates, and the enclosed sheet for buffet menus. Dinners will be available on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 6:00-6:30pm in the 2nd Floor Teachers' Lounge. We will post a chart reminding students of their orders; please ask them to check the chart each night BEFORE taking their dinner to avoid mistakes. If the Netivon calendar changes and an evening is cancelled, we will refund the money you had paid for the dinner order that night. If a student is absent on a scheduled day of class, however, no refund will be given, since orders are placed with Chef Annie, Chizuk Amuno's in-house caterer, in advance.

### **Kosher Food**

Chizuk Amuno's policy on outside food: prepared food from home is allowed, as long as it is dairy or pareve; prepared food from a non-kosher restaurant must be cold only (salads, sandwiches, etc.) AND be dairy or pareve.

### **Homework and Grades**

Our students are here because they enjoy learning with each other, and our teachers are here because they love learning with your teens! Netivon learning is about class time and class discussion, so there are no grades, and only occasional homework for Hebrew classes. Even though there are no grades, we are very happy to prepare a transcript with descriptions of your courses for your college applications.

### **Attendance**

Because class participation is so important to the success of Netivon, we want to make sure that you're here! We keep careful track of daily attendance, and students are limited to 8 absences throughout the year. Also, please note that 3 late arrivals or early dismissals equal one absence. If a student exceeds the allowed absence number, we will sit with the student at the end of the year to work out a meaningful, personally-relevant summer equivalency project.
